“Colors of Joy” 2018 NorthStar Watermedia Society Art Exhibition

NorthStar Watermedia Society (NSWS) announces “Colors of Joy” the springtime Membership Exhibition displaying up to one hundred original paintings to be held at the White Bear Unitarian Universalist Church, 328 Maple Street, Mahtomedi, MN. Art work will be on display and open to the public April 8 – May 13, 2018, Mon – Thurs from 10:00 AM to 4 PM. A reception will be held on May 10, 2018 from 6 – 8:30 PM with a presentation of awards at 7:00 PM featuring well-known St. Paul artist, Tara Sweeney, who will give a critique on chosen award winners’ artwork.

Members of NSWS will have submitted one carefully chosen painting for the exhibition. Paintings are created using watercolor, acrylic, casein, gouache, water-soluble inks and/or egg tempera. Most works are offered for sale.

NorthStar Watermedia Society is the oldest watermedia society in Minnesota and was formed in the White Bear Lake area in 1975. NSWS promotes the artistic use of water based media with 225 members from the Twin Cities area, outstate Minnesota and Wisconsin.

Member privileges include monthly meetings featuring demonstrations by local, nationally and internationally known watermedia artists who teach techniques and approaches to the media. There are also group painting opportunities, an annual national juried show, a member show/sale at the MN State Fairgrounds Fine Arts building, monthly peer review and voting and other activities. Opportunities for involvement include many board, committee and volunteer positions. Monthly meetings are held at the Roseville Oval at 7:00 PM on the Third Thursday of each month.
